Your letter dated 22nd September 2009, addressed to my client, the Hon. Milinda Moragoda, M.P., Minister of Justice, has been handed over to me with instructions to reply thereto.

Your reference to your client as "Advisor to His Excellency the President" is misplaced and certainly improper in as much as the letter in question emanates from you on his behalf in his capacity as a litigant. His position as a Presidential Advisor does not render him a privileged suitor or add any weight to the unwarranted allegations contained in the said letter. It would appear that this reference is calculated to vest the letter with a veneer of the credibility which to your client's knowledge it is bereft of.

My client is at a loss to understand the relevance of serving on my client the purported notice of the contents of the letter addressed to the Editor "Sunday Leader".

My client denies that he has been instrumental in, or privy to, the publication of the news report. My client has reason to believe that your letter is an attempt on the part of your client to create a defence for himself in regard to the allegations in the news report in question and a calculated attempt to tarnish my client's reputation. I have to draw your attention to the fact that the Supreme Court in the proceedings initiated by Dr.P.B.Jayasundara in the above case observed that your client's conduct savoured of the persecution of Dr. Jayasundara. You would note that the Supreme Court in its order, observed that the process of the Courts should not be used for the persecution of individuals.

The allegations against my client in respect of the above application are without foundation and pure conjecture on the part of your client. In the circumstances, please advise your client to take note particularly of the observations of the Supreme Court and desist from forwarding such meaningless and vituperative letters.
